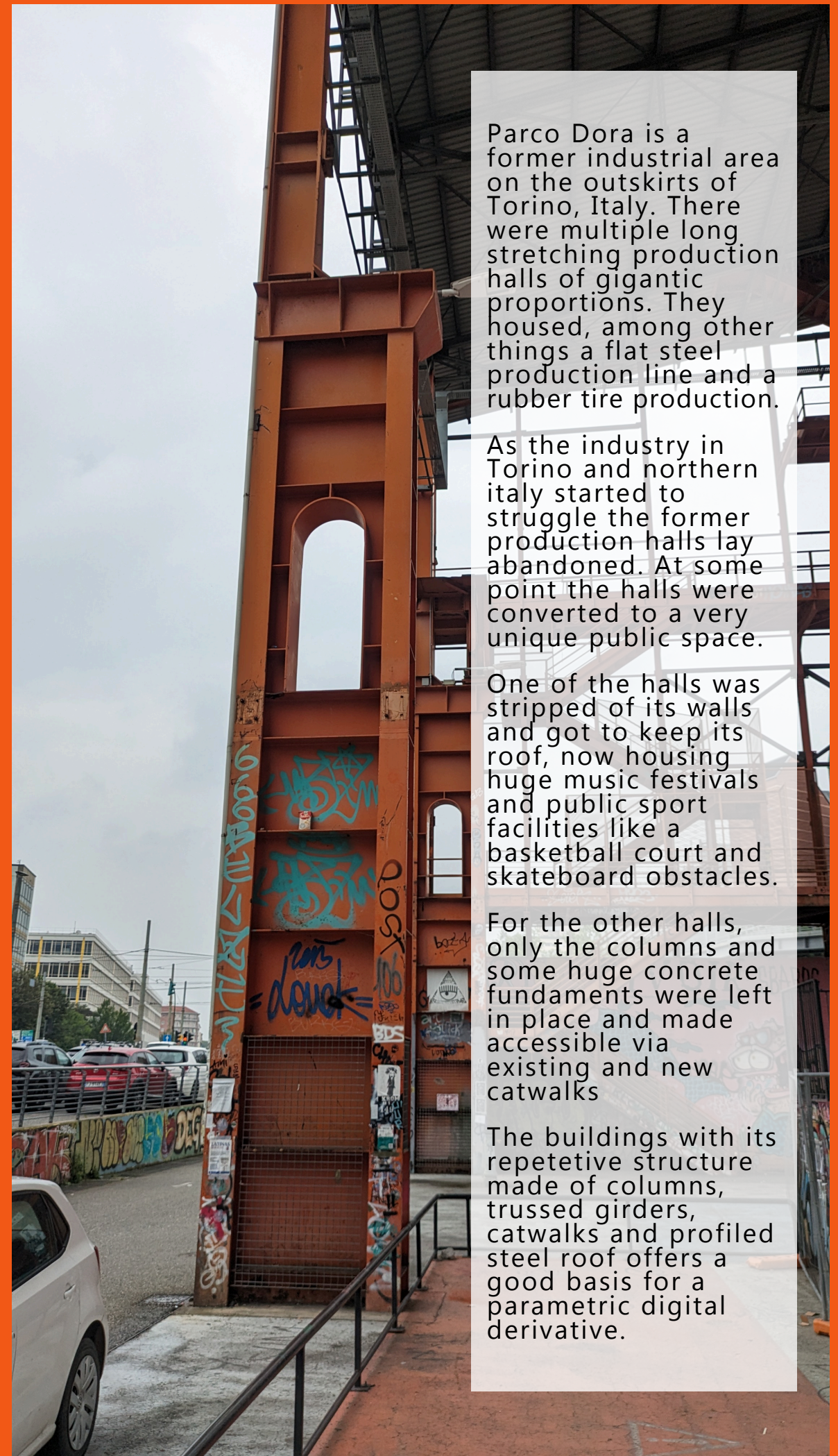

**concept - Parco Dora, Torino**



Parco Dora is a former industrial area on the outskirts of Torino, Italy. There were multiple long stretching production halls of gigantic proportions. They housed, among other things a flat steel production line and a rubber tire production.

As the industry in Torino and northern Italy started to struggle the former production halls lay abandoned. At some point the halls were converted to a very unique public space.

One of the halls was stripped of its walls and got to keep its roof, now housing huge music festivals and public sport facilities like a basketball court and skateboard obstacles.

For the other halls, only the columns and some huge concrete fundaments were left in place and made accessible via existing and new catwalks

The buildings with its repetitive structure made of columns, trussed girders, catwalks and profiled steel roof offers a good basis for a parametric digital derivative.
